

Campus Coach Job Covenant

- Attend the club meetings. The Equal-Access Act says that these must be student-led and/or student-initiated. You do not run the club. You coach the students!
- Meet with Students quarterly to plan and implement the club strategy.
- Provide resources for the club.
- Attend Monthly Network meetings with other church youth ministers, youth workers, and campus coaches in your area.

Other Suggestions: (not required but strongly encouraged)

- Have an outreach event for your campus.
- Help recruit new youth ministers/workers to help with the club.

The Bottom Line These students need your leadership and guidance. You are the coach. A student with excitement but no direction is like a jet engine with no wings. Give these students wings! It is important that you help keep the club's mission and vision clear. First Priority is simply the plan. Your leadership is essential to the club's success.
